

Rogeros of Menorca

From Menorca (1550) to Florida (1997),
we Rogeros have 447 years of wonderful heritage.

The Early Lineage:

It begins in the year 1550 on the Island of Minorca and is associated with three towns; Mahón, Alayor, and Ferrerías. Ciudadela's records were consulted also.

PEDRO ROTGER was the first known ancestor. He was a master artisan and married to ISABEL TRIAY. They lived in Mahón, a port town on the southeastern side of the island. The year was about 1550. He was ALBERTO'S GREAT, GREAT, GREAT, GRANDFATHER.

JUAN ROGERO, as it was later spelled, was baptized 4/22/1593 and was married twice. The second nuptials were performed on 6/11/1623 to PRACEDES SINTES. He was ALBERTO'S GREAT, GREAT, GRANDFATHER.

ANTONIO ROGERO, Juan's son, was baptized in Alayor on 12/8/1641. He married CATALINA SALAS on 8/8/1671 and was ALBERTO'S GREAT, GRANDFATHER.

JUAN ROGERO II was baptized on 12/28/1677, also in the town of Alayor. He moved to Ciudadela (in Menorca). He, too, was married twice. His second wedding took place on 5/2/1708 to JUANA GELEVERT. He became ALBERTO'S GRANDFATHER.

Now we come to **RAMON ROGERO**, who was born in Ciudadela, on 11/22/1716. There, he married CATALINA LLINA on 9/10/1741. RAMON was ALBERTO'S father. When RAMON and CATALINA took the journey from Minorca to Florida in 1768, they brought their youngest child, ALBERTO, with them.

ALBERTO ROGERO was born on 5/3/1756, the youngest of Ramon's children. His siblings were:

- Juana, born 1745
- Juan, born 1747
- Catalina, born 1749
- Ramon, born 1751
- Esberto, born 1753

ALBERTO ROGERO married **ANTONIA VILA** in St. Augustine in 1782, and became the *Patriarch of all the known Rogeros in the United States of America.*
