

Pellicer Lineage

SEREFIN PELLICER was the original ancestor in the ancient colony of *Rafal* near Alayor. He and his wife, MARGARITA PONS, lived in the middle of the 16th century on the Isle of Minorca.

Their son, SEREFIN PELLICER, the younger, was baptized on the 16th day of March in 1583 in Alayor. When he became of age, he was wed to JUANA ALBERTI on January 31, 1606.

SEREFIN and JUANA had a son named JUAN PELLICER. He was baptized July 29, 1611. They still lived in Alayor, with the family. He married JUANA BAGUR, April 27, 1641, in Ferrerías, Minorca.

The next carrier of the line, JUAN and JUANA'S SON, ANTONIO PELLICER, was born in 1653 in Ferrerías, but grew up in Alayor. He married MARGARITA HUGUET on February 16, 1675.

ANTONIO PELLICER, JR. was born November 12, 1686. The family still lived in Alayor. He married ANTONIA MASCARO on February 2, 1715.

ANTONIO PELLICER, III, next in line, was born May 20, 1716, and baptized in the Cathedral at Alayor. He was married in that same Cathedral on July 10, 1746, to JUANA SINTES. It was their son, FRANCISCO PELLICER, SR., who came to Florida in 1768, to lay the foundation for the PELLICER family.

So, FRANCISCO PELLICER, SR., a native of Alayor, baptized there on February 7, 1753, was but a 15-year old boy when he arrived in New Smyrna in 1768. In 1777, he was one of the leaders of the trek to British Augustine.

FRANCISCO, SR. married JUANA VILA. (She was the sister of ANTONIA VILA, ALBERTO ROGERO'S wife.) They were married on March 2, 1783, the year after Alberto married Antonia. (This was Francisco's second marriage following the death of his first wife.)

"On Tuesday, November 19th, 1805, I, Don Miguel Crosby, priest, vicar, and Ecc'l Judge of the Parish church and Province of St. Augustine in Florida, baptized a child born on the 24th day of October, same year, daughter legitimate of Francisco Pellicer, son of Antonio Pellicer and Juana Sintes, natives of Leon, Isle of Menorca.

During the church ceremony, I gave the name, Rafaela Margarita. Godparents Don Francisco Rovira and Margarita Pellicer, of whom I advised of their spiritual obligations."
